Chang Cheng Chinese School Introduction to New Coaches/Teachers

William Bi, Chen style TaiJiQuan Coach

Mr. William Bi started his practice of Chen TaiJiQuan soon after he finished the basic WuShu training in China. He have practiced for more than twenty years of Chen TaiJiQuan and have won many awards both in China the Unites States, including the first price in TaiJi Invitation Competition in Guangdong 2001 and the gold metal in U.C Berkeley Wushu Tournament 2005.

In this class, he will introduce the common principles in TaiJiQuan by practicing the Chen style original "Old Form", practicing the traditional qigong method, and doing the unique silk-reeling exercise.

Chen style TaiJiQuan is the oldest and parent form of the five main TaiJiQuan. It was developed at Chenjiagou, Henan, China at around 1600s. Chen style TaiJiQuan had always been practiced and passed on inside of the Chen family. The original and common form is called "Old Form", which is stilled practiced in Chen Village today. Chen TaiJiQuan is characterized by the explicit twisting movement and burst of power. In recent decades, Chen style TaiJiQuan has come to be recognized as a major style of martial art in China and in many countries for either martial art or healthy life-style reasons.

Millard Baker, Youth Basketball Coach

Mr. Millard Baker works for a major bank in Sacramento as a Senior System Administrate. He has over eleven years experience in coaching youth and high school basketball teams. Between 1991 and 1994, he received full basketball scholarship from University of California at Santa Barbara and played on a Division 1 Basketball team for four years.

Following his youth coaching philosophy, Mr. Millard Baker works with the understanding that little eyes are looking upon you for guidance and leadership. He always encourages the student/athlete to work towards reaching their goal of playing at the highest level they can without setting false expectations.
